In 2015, Wolf Den employees worked 27,552 hours with a lost-time incident rate of zero. Wolf Den has operated for more than three years without a safety incident. Its last and only, recordable incident occurred in December 2012.

"Commitment to safety and environmental protection make up the strong foundation of our operating philosophy," said John W. Eaves, Arch's chief executive officer. "We drive that message home to our employees every day through a number of initiatives, and awards such as this one recognize their dedicated efforts. The Sentinels of Safety Awards, sponsored annually by NMA, recognize the nation's safest mines. The awards are given to coal and mineral mining operations in 10 categories for recording the most hours in a calendar year without a lost-time injury. A minimum of 4,000 hours are required for award consideration. The award categories reflect the safety accomplishments of both small and large mines, mills and preparation plants.
