

Arch Coal's First Quarter Conference Call To Be Webcast, Podcast

ST. LOUIS (April 19, 2007) – Arch Coal, Inc. (NYSE:ACI) will discuss its first quarter 2007 financial results in a conference call that will be broadcast live over the Internet on Monday, April 23, at 11:00 a.m. E.D.T. Participating on the call will be Arch's Chairman and Chief Executive Officer Steven F. Leer, President and Chief Operating Officer John W. Eaves and Senior Vice President and Chief Financial Officer Robert J. Messey.

Arch Coal's first quarter earnings release will be distributed via PR Newswire before the market opens on Monday, April 23, and will be posted to the company's Web site at that time.

St. Louis-based Arch Coal is one of the nation's largest coal producers. The company's core business is providing U.S. power generators with clean-burning, low-sulfur coal for electric generation. Through its national network of mines, Arch supplies the fuel for approximately 6 percent of the electricity generated in the United States.
